This project involved the conversion of a vacated bank headquarters in downtown Kokomo into a medical office building to house the hospital's outpatient behavioral health department and financial services. The extensive scope of renovation involved replacing the entire exterior skin of the existing building complex, comprised of sections built in 1889, 1961 and 1978, to create a unified, contemporary appearance. All new interior wall partitions, room finishes and mechanical/electrical systems were installed within the existing building structure. The project not only provides the hospital with a state-of-the-art facility, but also enhances the city's downtown revitalization efforts and brings 90 hospital employees into the downtown area.
